Environmental & Waste Disposal Statement

Our Approach

At Local Tradie Services, we take rubbish removal and waste disposal seriously. We know that how your junk is handled matters — not just for a clean property, but for the environment and the wider Perth community. This statement explains how we manage, transport and dispose of waste from our rubbish removal, tip runs, small removals and handyman jobs.

1. Our Commitment

We aim to:

- Dispose of waste legally and responsibly at approved facilities.
- Reduce landfill where practical by sorting, re-using and recycling.
- Handle your rubbish in a way that is safe for you, our team and the environment.

We follow relevant Western Australian laws and local council guidelines for waste, transport and disposal.

2. What We Remove

We typically remove:

- General household junk and clutter
- Furniture, appliances and whitegoods
- Cardboard, packaging and light renovation waste
- Garden and green waste (branches, clippings, small trees)
- Garage and shed clear-outs

If you are unsure about a specific item, please ask when you request your quote.

3. What We Do Not Remove

For safety and compliance reasons, we usually cannot remove:

- Asbestos or suspected asbestos-containing materials
- Hazardous chemicals, solvents, oils, fuels or paints in poor condition
- Gas bottles (unless previously agreed and safe to transport)
- Explosives, ammunition or flammable solids
- Medical or biohazardous waste

If we suspect any load contains hazardous or prohibited materials, we may refuse removal and recommend a licensed specialist.



4. How We Dispose of Your Waste

We use a mix of:

- Licensed transfer stations and tips — for general mixed loads.
- Recycling and resource recovery facilities — where the site sorts and recovers materials such as metal, cardboard and green waste.

Where practical, we:

- Separate green waste for mulching/composting facilities.
- Identify metal items (e.g. bed frames, appliances) that may go to metal recycling.
- Keep clean cardboard and paper separate when loads allow.

Exact processes can vary depending on load type and volume, facility availability and location, and council and facility rules at the time of disposal.

5. Donations, Re-Use and Repurposing

When items are in reasonable, usable condition and it is practical to do so, we may offer them for re-use or donation (e.g. to charities, community groups or individuals), or repurpose suitable materials for internal use (e.g. for moving, packing or storage). We do not guarantee that specific items will be donated or re-used, but we try to avoid sending good items straight to landfill where a sensible alternative exists.

6. Tip Fees and Transparency

Tip and facility fees in Perth can vary by material type, volume or weight, and specific facility rules or surcharges. Our quotes aim to be upfront and transparent:

- Many rubbish removal and tip run jobs are quoted inclusive of tip fees, based on the photos and details you provide.
- Where appropriate, we may itemise tip or facility charges separately on your quote or invoice.

If disposal costs are likely to be higher than standard (e.g. unusually heavy or tricky loads), we will explain this in advance wherever possible.

7. Transport and Load Safety

We take care to:

- Secure loads properly with appropriate restraints and covers.
- Avoid overloading vehicles or trailers beyond safe or legal limits.
- Comply with relevant road transport and load restraint guidelines.

If a load is unsafe or too heavy to transport in one trip, we may split it into multiple loads or recommend an alternative solution such as a skip bin or specialist service. Any agreed changes will be discussed with you before we proceed.

8. Your Responsibilities

To help us handle your waste safely and responsibly, we ask that you:

- Tell us in advance about any materials you suspect may be hazardous (e.g. asbestos, chemicals).
- Keep pets and children away from work areas during loading.
- Avoid mixing clearly hazardous items into general rubbish piles.

If we arrive and find prohibited or unsafe items mixed into a load, we may refuse to remove those items, suggest a specialist contractor, and/or adjust the quote if additional handling or sorting is required.



9. Continuous Improvement

Waste rules, recycling options and facility capabilities change over time. We review our disposal options as new facilities or programs become available and adapt our processes to reflect current best practice and regulatory requirements. This may mean your load is handled slightly differently depending on where you are, what's in the load, and what facilities are available at the time.
